

We are all so glad that our brutally hot summer has come to an end, and although it's faint, you can feel the seasons changing with slightly cooler mornings and just a hint of lower humidity. It was a long summer for the agronomy department, but our team did a great job managing the courses in the face of record heat, extreme drought, and more than a few hurdles to negotiate. But in the past few weeks, we have been blessed with some timely rain, and we are very grateful for that.

This time of the year is critical for agronomy

as we apply several key pre-emergent herbicides to the courses. These applications will be crucial for us in our war against winter weeds and providing the best course conditions possible. We began the applications in September and will continue them through November. Currently we are battling an aggressive weed called goosegrass that has infected multiple greens on the course.

Normal fertilization continues with products designed to provide nutrition throughout the cooler months. Overseeding of the greens along with the par 3 tee boxes will start at month's end. This year we will be using a 3-way blend of perennial ryegrass. As always please sand your divots and repair your ball marks. Thank you!

Water

Did you know..... To water all fairways, tee boxes and greens it takes a full 8-hour non-stop cycle. That means that first green that gets watered won't get water again for at least 7 1/2 hours.





DIANA LEWIS



A price sheet will be available in the Shop October 10th. Call Jeff if you have any questions.






