BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Let's kick off 2024 on a high note with improving the club! This month or in early March the lake excavation project will begin. This will help the irregation system and limit the silt from getting into the lines and breaking sprinkler heads. This will also be instrumental with water retention and increasing the useable water during droughts and also when the on course irrigation system gets improved.

The Board has approved to aerify all fairways twice this year, once in April and once in July. This will help with the growth and consistency of the turf- we all want better fairways!

In lieu of a dues increase the board has opted to increase usage fees on several programs which have not kept up with the cost of operating and increased utilization.

The board of directors voted to raise the fees for cart storage, trail, cart rental and the cart program beginning in March. Due to inflationary costs of fuel, electricity, insurance and other operational costs, restructuring of the Fees Program is warranted.

Projected Operational Cost for 2024 = \$270,000 (44% higher than 2021).

It has been eight years (2016) since these fees have changed and due to inflationary costs a increase was needed. Below will be the new fees per month starting in March.

- -Cart Storage \$65
- -Trail \$50
- -Cart Program \$100
- -Half Cart Rental- per 18 holes \$20

The member survey results have been posted on the bulletin board at the Club. We will go into more detail on future projects, their costs and timelines in next months newsletter. The suggestions box is still in the clubhouse for your convenience.

When this occurs, there cannot be any contact with any turf at the Club. Depending on how long the duration of the freeze is determines when we can get on the turf after the temps rise above 32 degrees. If there is a long freeze through the night, then we usually need to get to a safe temp of 40 degrees before we can open the course and practice areas. We will try and alert you via text with updates, but we are limited on how many texts we can send out. If you ever are questioning the course availability and don't receive a text, please call the Club before coming out.

It is one of the more exciting times of the year when all of the golf manufactures come out with new equipment. Taylor Made, Callaway and Titleist have new clubs and balls, Footjoy has apparel and shoes! All of these items you can get through the Club and you will save money. If there is anything that you need, please contact me so we can get you taken care of.

Please make sure you are filling your divots, fixing your ball marks, and make sure you are extra careful of where you drive your cart on days the course is not Cart Path Only. The course conditions will reap the benefits of conscientious players which is in the best interest of all members.


